- **Find out how your state compares:** Learn how your state measures up to others on specific policies.

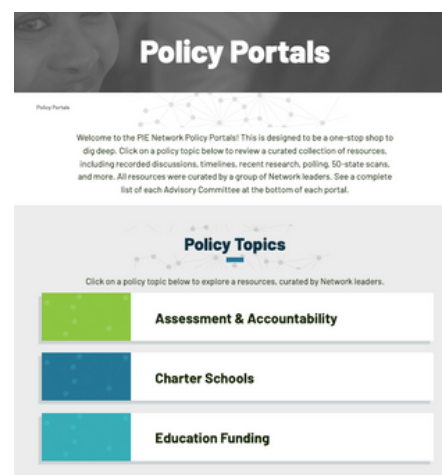

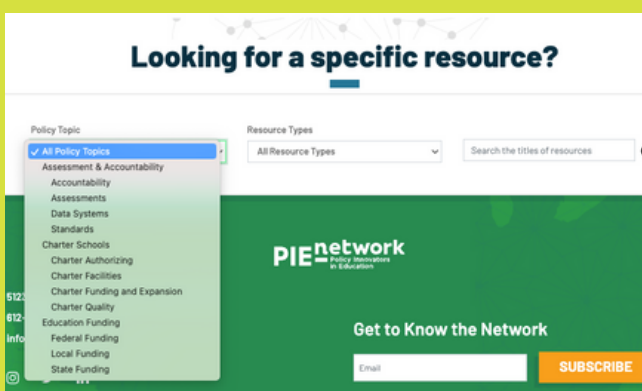
Log in or create a user account. All staff at PIE Network member organizations are eligible to instantly create an account

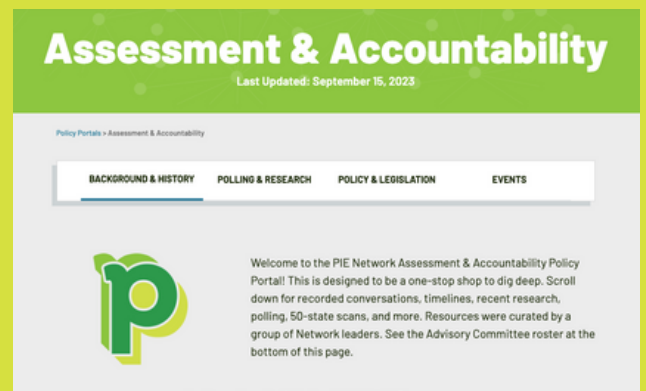
Know exactly what you're looking for?

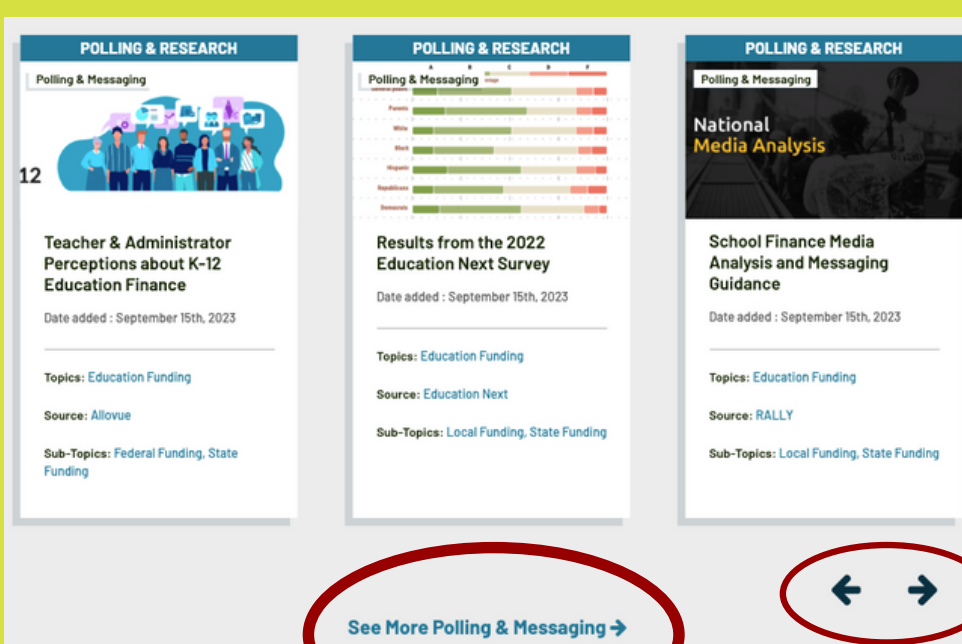
